Statement of CBGA Participation

The Cascade Boer Goat Association and its Board of Directors are providing a service to the members of the association through the annual CBGA Boer-Nanza sale.

This is done via the Herdbuilder online auction platform.

In no way does the Association make any guarantees or warranties to the offerings of consigning members.

Payment

An invoice will be sent from Herdbuilder to all winning bidders. Payment needs to be completed within 24 hours of the conclusion of the sale.

If the individual consignor and buyer wish to make a direct payment, the consignor will need to notify Herdbuilder that payment has been completed.

All payment must be in US currency.

Any payment methods that incur an additional fee will be the sole responsibility of the buyer.

Each consignor's contact information is listed in the catalog. If a buyer wishes to make other arrangements for payment with a consignor, contact must be made PRIOR to bidding.

Consignors reserve the right to hold goats on their property until payment has cleared.

Care After Sale

Consignors will hold your purchase at their respective farms for 10 days without charge while transportation arrangements are made. For additional time, please contact the consignor.

Transportation and Health Certificates

All costs of transport and associated veterinary inspection is the responsibility of the buyer.

Transfer of Ownership

The rights of ownership shall not pass until settlement has been made. The risk of ownership transfers at the conclusion of the sale. All registered animals will have papers signed off in the proper manner by the seller. Cost of transferring ownership with the ABGA is that of the buyer.

International Buyers

Be advised that all international buyers must have a US based representative to facilitate all aspects of the purchase, payment, and transportation for any animal purchased from this sale.

Warranties and Guarantees

ALL ANIMALS IN THIS SALE ARE OFFERED AS IS, WHERE IS.

Any warranties or guarantees either written, expressed, or implied are solely between the buyer and seller. Any statements of testing for pregnancy, herd health, DNA, etc. is solely the responsibility of the seller.

Rights and Obligations

The above terms of sale shall constitute a contract between the buyer and seller and be equally binding to both. The CBGA shall in no way be liable for any transaction occurring from this sale.
