<http://www.skamaniacountyfair.com/directions.htm> Most of you will take I-84 through the gorge, take exit 44 (Cascade Locks), cross over the toll-bridge Bridge of the Gods and then head a short way east on Highway 14 in Washington. Turn left off of 14 at the sign for Skamania Lodge, and follow that road to the fairgrounds (past the lodge).

Arrival Info: Pens will be available after 3pm on June 27th. When you arrive find a show host to show you the location of your pens. Your animals *must be health-checked* before entering the barn. Animals exhibiting signs of infection with soremouth, heel mites, CL or any other contagious disease will not be allowed to unload. Please move your vehicle to a parking area as soon as you are unloaded so that others are able to unload near the barn entrances.

Camping: Camping is available on the fairgrounds and there are hookups. Camping fees are \$20 if you use a hookup and \$15 without a hookup. Please call the office 509-427-3980 if you have questions. No dogs are allowed on the fairgrounds.

Selling Goats: You are welcome to offer goats for sale by posting signs on your pens *if they are entered in at least two of our four shows*. We do not have sufficient pens to allow sales of goats not entered in the show.

ABGA Show Information:

Dates: Saturday, June 28th: Two ABGA shows
Sunday, June 29th: One ABGA show

Show Information:

Start time: Saturday: the first ABGA show will begin at **8am** on Saturday, June 28th; the second show will follow the first.

Sunday: the ABGA show will start at **9 am**.

Location: All three ABGA open shows will occur in the north showing, located outdoors between the livestock barn and horse barn.

Judges: Show 1: Joe Teel; Show 2: Warren Thigpen; Show 3: Sherri Stephens

Registration: Animals entered into the ABGA shows must be registered with one of the recognized Boer goat registries (exception: ABGA does not recognize USBGA Native on Appearance or USBGA percentage bucks registrations). Original registration certificates must be presented at check-in for any animal over 3mo old regardless of which registry they are registered with, per ABGA rules. Stamped received copies of applications for animals under 3mo old will be accepted. All three ABGA shows are official ABGA shows and ABGA rules shall govern. Please note: owners are responsible for ensuring their animals have legible tattoos; the judge will be the final determinant of legibility and reserves the right to dismiss any animal for lack of a legible tattoo per ABGA rules

Entries: The show hosts reserve the right to close any or all of the three ABGA shows to entries at any point prior to the show due to pen space or number of entries. If the show has not been closed by the show hosts, entries can be made until 7am on June 28th for the ABGA shows. Substitutions will be allowed until 7am on June 28th. Entries received after June 15th will not be in the show program.

NEW!! Entry DATE Requirements: **We are instituting a new entry practice used in other livestock shows. Please read this section carefully.**

Opening date: May 15, 2008

Entries will be accepted with postmarks on or after the opening date. *All entries must be delivered via mail or email. Entries sent without payment will not be considered received until payment is received. Payment may be made by check or by Paypal. No entries please before May 15th. Entries will be taken until the show is full due to pen space or number of entries. Show hosts may request that tack pens be shared. Pens are large enough to be shared by multiple goats (with the exception of senior bucks who can be housed singly).*
