**Location:** Clark County Fairgrounds at Exit 9 on I-5 in Ridgefield, WA

**Directions:** Ridgefield is located off of I-5 on the north side of Vancouver, WA. From the south head north on either I-5 or I-205, and just after the two freeways merge, take exit 9 and turn left to get to the Clark County Fairgrounds; enter at the multilane entrance on the left past the horse entrance – proceed to the yellow gate. From the north, take I-5 south to exit 9 and turn right for the fairgrounds; enter at the multilane entrance on the left past the horse entrance – proceed to the yellow gate.

**Arrival Info:** Pens will be available after 3pm on July 1st. The livestock barn and small animal barns are on the south side of the Clark County fairgrounds by the yellow gate. Please leave your animals on the trailer until after they have been health-checked. Most of the pens are very strong newer metal pens with vertical bars. If you are bringing very small kids, you may want to bring mesh to line your pens. Straw to bed the pens will be provided.

**Camping:** Tent and RV camping are available on the fairgrounds (no hook-ups). Camping fees are \$20 per family per night. There are many grassy areas on the fairgrounds where you are welcome to set up your tents and paved or gravel areas for parking RV on the grounds. There are bathrooms near the barn with showers available. No fireworks allowed on the grounds. Outdoor barbeques are welcomed if done safely outside the barn with adult supervision.

**Dogs:** Dogs on the fairgrounds must be on leash at all times and are not allowed in the barns unless by special permission from the hosts. *Please* clean up any solid souvenirs left by your dog as nobody wants to see, smell, or step in your dog's mess.

**Hotels:** There are several hotels one exit south of the fairgrounds in Salmon Creek, WA. La Quinta Inn, Holiday Inn Express Hotel, Days Inn at Salmon Creek, and Shilo Inn at Salmon Creek are close by. The Days Inn and Shilo have restaurant, fast food and a grocery store in easy walking distance.

**What is a JABGA Regional Show?** This is an opportunity for children to show animals that are registered with ABGA in the child's name. The JABGA regional show is for junior members of the American Boer Goat Association to show their registered Boer Goats in a youth only show.

The show will include: Percentage Does, Purebred or Fullblood Does, and Bucks.

There will be **ribbons** through 5<sup>th</sup> place, **premiums** through 3<sup>rd</sup> place, and **Silver Belt Buckles** for overall champions & reserve champions. Our thanks and appreciation to the JABGA for providing all prizes associated with the JABGA show.

**Start Time Approx: 2:00pm** on Saturday, July 2<sup>nd</sup>. JABGA show will follow the open show.

**Judge:** ABGA Judge Chip Kemp

**Check-in:** Friday evening or Saturday before noon; original registration papers must be presented. **Per the JABGA rules, the goat must be registered in the youth exhibitor's name.**

### JABGA Show Rules:

1. Exhibitors must be in accordance of the JABGA By-Laws in terms of age and be an active member of the Junior American Boer Goat Association. Must present JABGA Membership card at check-in. (*note: age requirement is that the exhibitor must have been 18 or under on January 1, 2011*).
2. If the child is present and physically able, they must show their own animal unless they have multiple entries; then they must have another JABGA member to show the animal for them.
3. If the child is physically unable or not present due to circumstances such as death in the family, family emergencies, religious reasons, etc; they must have a JABGA member show for them, and it must be reported before the goats arrive at the show.
4. JABGA members under the age of nine (9), as of January 1, or members with physical or mental disabilities are allowed to have a heeler in the class, but the member must help in the presentation of the animal. The heeler must be a JABGA member.
5. **All goats over the age of ninety (90) days must be in the individuals name forty-five (45) days prior to the show.**
6. All ABGA rules, breed standards, classes, judges and entries apply.

**Entries:** Entries and/or substitutions can be made until noon on July 2nd for the JABGA Show. Entries received after June 20<sup>th</sup> will not be in the show program. JABGA show entries are \$10 dollars per class entry if paid prior to June 20<sup>th</sup>. Late entries are \$12 per class.

## CBGA Youth Show Information:

**The CBGA Youth Show is our annual Market Goat and Showmanship Show.**

**Date:** Sunday, July 3rd

**Start time:**

**Weigh-in: 8 to 10am:** All market goats must be weighed in between 8 and 10am on Sunday. Health checks are required prior to weigh-in, so please arrive early enough to finish weigh in prior to 10am

**Check-in: 8 to 10am:** Please check-in for showmanship and market goat classes. You can register on-site if you have not pre-registered.

**Showmanship:** Showmanship is a **free class** and will begin at **10am** in the youth show ring. The order of classes will be posted prior to 10am.

**Market Goats:** The Market Goat show will follow the showmanship divisions.

**Rate of Gain:** ROG award is for market goats purchased at the April Fools Sale. ROG will be calculated by using the April Fools weight and the CBGA Youth Show weight at weigh in.

**Registration:** Animals shown Sunday in the showmanship or market goat classes are not required to be registered in order to be entered. Any percentage Boer is welcome. Does or wethers are allowed in the youth showmanship classes. Does or wethers may be shown in the market goat classes (but does may not be cross-entered in the ABGA open or JABGA shows). Please, no bucks allowed in showmanship or market goat classes. Market goats must meet requirements as listed in the 'Market Goat Rules' page of this packet.

**Entries:** Entries and/or substitutions can be made until 10am on July 3rd for the Youth Show. Entries received after June 20<sup>th</sup> will not be in the show program. Market Goat classes are \$10 dollars per class entry if paid prior to June 20<sup>th</sup>. Late entries are \$12 per class.

**Showmanship:** We strongly encourage all youth 18 and under to show in the **FREE** showmanship classes. The competitor does not need to own the goat in classes from Pee Wee through Intermediate. If you don't have a goat of your own at the show, borrow one and show! Does or wethers of any age may be used. Children in the Pee Wee division may have a parent or older sibling go into the ring with them to help – our goal for that age group is for the child to have lots of fun showing and want to do it again! Senior showmen will be held to a higher standard in the ring. Use your own goat and fit it yourself.

**You can win a free doeling** . All youth who enter either showmanship or the poster contest will be entered into a free drawing for a Boer doe kid donated by **TLC Boer Goats**. If you enter both showmanship and the poster contest you will get two ticket entries into the drawing ! Note: You must have your parent's permission to win the doe.

## Market Goat Classes

1. Novice Showman
2. Bred By Exhibitor
3. Open Division

## Rules for Youth Market Goat Classes

1. Exhibitors must have owned and cared for the market goat for a minimum of 60 days (or since birth if animal is less than 60 days old).
2. Exhibitors must have been 18 years old or under on Jan 1, 2011
3. Market Goats must be uniformly clipped 3/8 inch or less above the knees and hock joints prior their weigh-in.
4. Market goat must be less than one year old. No breaking of skin or eruption of permanent front teeth.
5. Market animals must be permanently identified. They must have a scrapies tag or tattoo in place.
6. In the event that more than one of an exhibitor's entries fall into the same weight class, another youth exhibitor will be allowed to handle the animal in youth classes on their behalf; adults may not show on a child's behalf; the owner of the animal must be present at Red, White & Boer and show their own animal unless they are in the ring with another animal at the same time.
7. Doe kids may not be cross-entered in any open-show ABGA or JABGA classes at Red, White & Boer. They are either exhibited in the market division or the breed show(s), but not both. No bucks in the market goat division or showmanship classes.
8. The first and second place animal from each weight class will return for the selection of Champion and Reserve Champion. (Novice Showman class not eligible)
9. The highest placing market animal in each class that was purchased from the April Fool sale will win an additional cash award.
10. A new class will be offered for novice exhibitors this year. This division is for youth that have exhibited in less than 3 goat events. All fairs, open and jackpot shows count as an event.
11. Bred By Exhibitor class: Child must have owned the dam at the time of birth of the market animal.
12. Dog chain type collars are suggested for use in the show ring.
13. Horned and disbudded goats are allowed.

## Educational **Poster Contest** for Youth

Pee Wees will be entering a coloring contest. Novices entering a drawing contest. Juniors, Intermediates and Seniors will be entering educational posters.

**What:** The Cascade Boer Goat Association (CBGA) is sponsoring a youth poster contest. All posters entered in the contest become the property of CBGA and will be used for educational display purposes at fairs. They will not be returned to the creator.  
**No entry fee.**

**When:** Poster to be turned in at the Red, White, and Boer Show by 10am on Sunday July 3<sup>rd</sup>.. Judging will be held the same day and winners announced at the end of lunch break.

**Where:** Clark County Fairgrounds, turn in at youth check-in, near South Show ring.

**How: Pee Wee:** Color the page at the end of this packet.

**Novice:** Draw a picture about Boer Goats.

**Junior, Intermediates & Seniors:** Design and submit an educational poster. Themes for your poster may be Boer Goats or Meat Goat products/production. Posters size may vary, but a standard Dollar-Store poster board is fine. Judges will be scoring the posters based on their readability from a distance (readers often stand 6-8ft away from the poster at fairs), educational content, attractiveness and creativity.
