

Cascade Boer Goat Association Boer-Nanza Production Sale

General Information:

- The date for the sale is Saturday, August 24, 2019.
- Preview of lots will begin at 9:00 AM.
- The sale will begin at Noon.
- Consignments must be in place by Saturday 8:30 AM.
- Consignors may start bringing goats on Friday, August 23, 2018 at Noon.
- The sale will be at Southwest Washington Fairgrounds: 2555 N. National Avenue, Chehalis, WA
- **Terry Taylor** will be examining all of the consigned goats and announcing the attributes of the goats during the auction.
- Livestock auctioneer **Pit Kemmer** will conduct the sale.
- **The 2019 Boer-Nanza sale will be broadcast live on DVAuction.**
- Buyers who cannot be at the sale may place bids through DVAuction, via proxy bids, or phone bids.

Consignment Information:

- 1) Only members in good standing with Cascade Boer Goat Association may consign Boer goats to the sale.
- 2) Consignment fees are \$60.00/per lot and are non-refundable, except in the unlikely event that the sale is canceled by the CBGA.
- 3) A commission, to be determined after the sale, will be assessed by CBGA to sold lots. Commission will be set with the goal of a zero balance for the sale. The commission will be capped at \$40 for any one lot, regardless of sales price.
- 4) In addition to the CBGA commission, Auctioneer Pit Kemmer charges a 1% commission on all sold lots. Pit Kemmer's commission will not be capped, and will be individually applied to all sold lots based on purchase price.
- 5) Initial consignment dates are May 1 to June 15, 2019. During this period each member farm may consign from 1 to 8 Boer goats to the sale. If the sale is not yet declared "full" by June 15, 2019, consignors may purchase up to two additional lots. Any consignment forms received before May 1 will not be considered. When the total number of consigned goats reaches 125, the sale will be declared full.
- 6) One semen or embryo lot will be allowed per consignor as consignments or substitutions but will be considered the same as a buck and subject to the same rules as bucks in rule 13. A donation semen consignment benefitting the April Fools Youth program will be allowed. The donation semen consignment will sell as lot #1 and will accommodate a reasonable number of donations at the sole discretion of the CBGA board.
- 7) Consignments are not considered 'reserved' until the consignment form is completed, and fees are paid in full. Paypal is the preferred method of payment and using "friends and family" when paying will not be required. The fees incurred by CBGA from Paypal will be considered a cost of the sale and offset with the commission. Personal checks will still be accepted as payment but will not be considered paid until the day they arrive in the sale chairman's mailbox.
- 8) In the event the sale is filled, a paid waiting list will be formed in the order the excess consignments are received. Prospective consignors not wishing to be or remain on the waiting list will be refunded in full at the time of their request. Prospective consignors on the waiting list not getting into the sale will be refunded in full after the sale.
- 9) Consignors wishing to relinquish all or part of their paid lots must contact the sale chairman for reissue to the waiting list, if there is a waiting list. Consignors cannot sell their lots to prospective consignors of their choosing. If there are no prospective consignors on the waiting list, the original consignor will not receive a refund of their consignment fees. If a consignor relinquishes their lot(s) on or before August 10, 2019, which are filled through the waiting list, the original consignor will receive a full refund of their consignment fees. Once the hard copy of the catalog is printed for the sale, there will be no reissue of lots or substitutions. Such lots will be scratched from the sale without refund.

- 10) Lots containing more than one animal are allowed if the animals involve kids that are still nursing on their dam. Also, lots containing no more than 2 weaned or older goats are allowed under the following conditions:
- a. No more than one lot with multiple weaned animals allowed per consignor. The consignment fee for the lot will be \$120.00, but the lot will sell as a unit at one time the money.
- 11) Photos, pedigree information and descriptions for consigned goats must be uploaded to Goatpromoter.com per the schedule below.
- 12) The catalog will be maintained on the Goatpromoter.com site.
- 13) Member farms consigning a minimum of 3 does, may also consign 1 buck. Member farms consigning a minimum of 6 does, may also consign up to 2 bucks. No farm may consign more than 2 bucks to the sale.
- 14) Consigned bucks must be registered. Unregistered Boer does shall be designated as such in the sale catalog and announced by the auctioneer. Dairy and other breed goats, less than 50% Boer, shall be excluded from this sale, unless they are implanted with boer goat embryos and confirmed to be pregnant.
- 15) Sellers may place reserves with the auctioneer. The floor price, unless instructed by the seller otherwise, will be \$300.00.
- 16) All consigned goats should be presented well groomed and in good health. Goats who exhibit signs of illness or a communicable condition will be pulled from the sale.
- 17) All consigned goats must arrive at the sale location with necessary documents. The documents should be in an unsealed large manila envelope. One envelope for each Lot consigned, labeled with the goat's lot #, farm name, and owner's name. The needed documents to enclose are:
- The original registration dated and signed on the back by the registered owner.
 - If a doe is being sold 'bred' or 'exposed' that must be noted properly on the back of the registration form.
 - A copy of testing results if the goat is being marketed as tested.

Sale Schedule:

May 1 – June 15, 2019	Initial consignment period.
June 16 – August 1, 2019	Consignors may purchase up to two additional lots if the sale is not yet declared "full"
July 1, 2019 – August 10, 2019	Photos, pedigree information and descriptions of consigned goats to be submitted for catalog
August 10, 2019	Final catalog updates
August 23, 2019	Consigned goats can start arriving at Noon to SWW Fairgrounds
August 24, 2019	All consigned goats should be in their pens by 9:00 AM when previewing begins. The sale will start at Noon.
